Wagon Master: Corky reported that as of the meeting time, he had received campground nominations for: Take It Easy Campground, White Oak Campground, Gettysburg Campground, Rockahock Campground, Old Mill Stream Campground, Madison Vines RV Resort, Cozy Acres Campground, American Heritage Campground, Fredericksburg KOA, Smallwood State Park, and Point Lookout State Park. Nominations could still be made through Sunday, August 18, 2024. Corky will be sending out a list of all the nominated campgrounds soon. From that list, each rig can vote for up to 6 destinations.

Hatti provided information about the recent updates to the Smallwood State Park Campground. The shortest campsite is 47 feet long, the longest campsite is 130 feet long. All sites have water and 50-amp hookups. While sites do not have sewer connections, there is a dump station at the exit. The camping rates for 2024 are \$27.50 per night on weekends. Reservations can be made up to a year in advance, and the park ranger suggested that camping after the kids go back to school in late August through October as they normally aren't as busy then.
